

## BROOKSIDE SCHOOL – SUPPLIES for GRADE ONE

The following is a list of basic supplies required for the commencement of the 2017-2018 school year. Parents are encouraged to renew supplies throughout the school year as required. **Please send all supplies to school with your child on Tuesday, September 5.**

- 10 Duotangs (not plastic) – 1 of each of the following colors: bright blue, grey, white, orange, green, navy, red, purple, black and yellow
- 1 **plastic** pencil boxes (**no bigger than 22 cm X 14 cm**)
- 1 pencil sharpener c/w receptacle
- 20 HB #2 pencils sharpened–Staedtler brand-blue
- 4 white **Vinyl** erasers (not plastic white erasers as they crumble)
- 1 pair scissors (e.g. Fiskars 5"pointed)
- 1 box pencil crayons (20 – 24) pre-sharpened (Staedtler)
- 1 pkg. **Prang** brand 8 water color paints (optional)
- 1 – 12 pack **Mr. Sketch** markers
- 1 pkg. Washable Narrow Felt markers 8 colours
- 1 pkg. of 24 Wax crayons
- 3 large size (40 grams) glue sticks
- 1 Hilroy blank scribbler 7" x 9"
- 1 **Hilroy interlined** scribbler (7" x 9")
- 2 Hilroy **half blank, half interlined** scribblers (7" x 9")
- 1 set of headphones c/w name in a ziplock bag
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

### Items needed in addition to these supplies:

- 1 pair indoor running shoes (to be left at school) **that the student can tie INDEPENDENTLY** (outdoor shoes may not be worn indoors due to damage to the gym floor)
- 1 backpack
- 1 Kanga Pouch – optional (can use one from Kindergarten) & 1 Agenda Book (optional) **Available from the school office in September**

### **Before sending supplies to school:**

- A. Please label **EACH INDIVIDUAL** crayon, felt pen, pencil crayon, scissors, glue sticks and white glue. Remove all wrapping from erasers, glue sticks and duotangs.

**PLEASE LABEL ALL SUPPLIES, INDOOR SHOES, OUTDOOR CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR, BACK PACK, AND LUNCH BAG, WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME OR INITIALS!!** A laundry marker works well.
