

BROOKSIDE SCHOOL – SUPPLIES for GRADE TWO

The following is a list of basic supplies required for the commencement of the 2017-2018 school year. **Please send all supplies to school with your child on Tuesday, September 5.** These items may need to be replenished throughout the year.

- 4 duotangs (red, blue, yellow, green (*these colors only please*))
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars pointed)
- 1 fine black sharpies
- 1 pencil sharpener c/w receptacle
- 30 HB pencils sharpened (Staedtler brand)
- 2 white Vinyl erasers
- 1 box of 24 Crayola pencil crayons, pre-sharpened
- 1 box of 10 fine tip Crayola felt markers (additional set may be required mid-year)
- 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 set of 10 Crayola or Prang water color paints (optional)
- 4 large(40 grams) glue sticks (will need more throughout year)
- 4 interlined blue exercise books
- 4 - ½ blank and ½ interlined green exercise books
- 1 blank paper exercise book for sketching & labelling
- 2 large Ziploc bags (Do NOT label with your child's name)
- 1 set of headphones
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

Items needed in addition to these supplies:

- 1 pair indoor running shoes (to be left at school) that the student can tie independently (outdoor shoes may not be worn indoors due to damage to the gym floor)
 - 1 Backpack
 - 1 Agenda Book (optional) **Available from the school office in September**

PLEASE LABEL INDOOR SHOES, OUTDOOR CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR, BACK PACK, AND LUNCH BAG, WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME OR INITIALS!! A laundry marker works well.
