

BROOKSIDE SCHOOL – SUPPLIES for GRADE THREE

The following is a list of basic supplies required for the commencement of the 2017-2018 school year. **Please send all supplies to school with your child on Tuesday, September 5.**

- 10 Duotangs – assorted colors
- 6 Hilroy wide rule exercise books – 40 pg.
- 1 1” 3-ring binder
- 1 250 pg. package of lined loose leaf paper
- 2 pencil boxes
- 20 HB pencils pre-sharpened – Dixon Oriole
- 1 pencil sharpener c/w receptacle for shavings.
- 2 white vinyl erasers (not plastic white erasers as they crumble)
- 1 ruler 30 cm
- 1 bottle 120 ml Elmer’s white glue
- 1 pair scissors (Fiskars)
- 1 box pencil crayons (20 – 24) pre-sharpened (Crayola pencil crayons are pre-sharpened)
- 1 pkg of 12 Washable Fine Tipped Felt markers 8 colours
- 1 set of 24 Water Color paints (optional)
- 4 large size (40 grams) glue sticks (replace as needed)
- 1 set of headphones c/w name in a ziplock bag for use with computers.
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

Items needed in addition to these supplies:

- 1 pair indoor running shoes (to be left at school) that the student can tie independently (outdoor shoes may not be worn indoors due to damage to the gym floor)
 - 1 backpack
 - 1 Agenda Book (optional) **Available from the school office in September**

PLEASE LABEL ALL SUPPLIES, INDOOR SHOES, OUTDOOR CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR, BACK PACK, AND LUNCH BAG, WITH YOUR CHILD’S NAME OR INITIALS!! A laundry marker works well.
