The following is a list of basic supplies required for the commencement of the 2017-2018 school year. Parents are encouraged to renew supplies throughout the school year as required. **PLEASE SEND ALL SUPPLIES TO SCHOOL WITH YOUR CHILD ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 5.**
We will use the first day to organize our materials.

- 24 HB pencils
- 4 white vinyl erasers
- 1 **plastic** pencil case
- Pencil sharpener c/w container for shavings
- 4 ball point pens (blue)
- 2 ball point pens (red)
- 1 metric ruler ****cm and mm**
- 2 coil scribblers (200 pages) - 8 1/2 x 11
- 12 duotangs, (2 of each blue, red, yellow, green, orange and black colors)
- 5 large (40 g) glue sticks
- 1 Elmer's white glue
- 2 highlighters (different colors incl. yellow)
- 1 box of oil pastels (optional)
- 2 black sharpies (1 fine & 1 extra fine)
- 1 set of 24 Crayola pencil crayons sharpened
- 1 set Crayola washable markers (fine-tipped)
- 1 pair pointed scissors
- 1 protractor (**not a set)
- 1 set of watercolor paints (Prang) (optional)
- 1 20 pg. Prang/Hilroy coiled scrapbook (optional)
- 1 inexpensive calculator
- 1 set of headphones c/w name in a ziplock bag for use with computers (optional)
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

Items needed in addition to these supplies:

1 pair running shoes to be left at school for indoor use only (outdoor shoes may not be worn indoors due to damage to the gym floor)

1 Agenda Book (optional) Available from the school office in September
