

BROOKSIDE SCHOOL – SUPPLIES – GRADE 6

The following is a list of basic supplies required for the commencement of the 2017-2018 school year. Parents are encouraged to renew supplies throughout the school year as required. **Please send all supplies to school with your child on TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 5.**

- 1 soft side pencil case
- 24 HB pencils
- 4 erasers
- Pencil sharpener c/w receptacle
- 4 ball point pens (blue)
- 4 ball point pens (red)
- 1 set markers
- 2 thin tip black sharpies
- 2 thick tip black sharpies
- 1 metric ruler ****cm only please – no inches**
- 8 coil scribblers (100 pages) - 8 1/2 x 11
- 1- 1 1/2" ring binder
- 2- 2 pkg. of 5 dividers
- 8 duotangs (different colors)
- 400 sheets lined loose leaf paper
- 4 40 g- glue sticks
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 set of 24 pencil crayons c/w case
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 protractor (**not a whole geometry set**)
- 1 inexpensive calculator with numbers to the billions (not scientific)
- 1 set of headphones **c/w name** in a ziplock bag for use with computers
- 2 boxes of facial tissue

Items needed in addition to these supplies:

- 1 pair running shoes to be left at school for indoor use only (outdoor shoes may not be worn indoors due to damage to the gym floor)
- 1 Agenda Book (optional) **Available from the school office in September**

PLEASE LABEL ALL SUPPLIES (send to school in a large clear plastic bag), SHOES, ESPECIALLY BOOTS (BEFORE YOU COME TO SCHOOL) AND OUTDOOR CLOTHING WITH YOUR NAME OR INITIALS!! A laundry marker works well.
